Warehouse Manager/Driver

Position Overview:

Responsibilities:

- Driving/Logistics
 - Gather and load materials and equipment per job material pick list
 - Safely transport and unload skids of materials and equipment to new and existing projects
 - Collect all remaining materials and equipment from jobsites for project clean-out
 - Pick up materials from vendor warehouses and transport to jobsite or warehouse
 - Work with vendors to ensure deliveries are accurate and received in a timely manner
 - Maintain fuel levels in fleet and communicate when maintenance and repairs are needed

Warehouse

- Responsible for managing warehouse inventory of material and equipment inventory and supplies
- Work up terrazzo samples and label/track accordingly
- Load and unload trucks with outgoing/incoming shipments
- Ensure all packing slips/items received are accurate and process receipts
- Request and arrange for repairs on various equipment as needed
- Maintain safe, organized, and clean warehouse
- Additional responsibilities, as needed

- CDL Type B License preferred, with good driving history
- Ability to operate forklift, or willingness to learn
